Colleges Functioning in the Country

†1220. SHRI ARUN SAO:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise number of the Government and private colleges functioning in the country including Chhattisgarh as on date;
- (b) the number of colleges in which posts of principals and professors are lying vacant along with the number of such colleges which lack library and other basic amenities;
- (c) the number of colleges receiving grants from University Grants Commission (UGC);
- (d) the norms for providing grants to private colleges; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to promote qualitative education in private and Government colleges?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT
(SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')**

(a): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that total 38,179 colleges are functioning in the Country. As per AISHE Report 2018-19 the State-wise detail of number of Government & Private Colleges functioning in the country is at **Annexure-I**.

(b): The posts of Principals and Professors are filled up by the State Governments concerned. However, out of 37645 Colleges which have uploaded their data on AISHE Portal 2018-19, there are 25315 sanctioned posts of Principals and 24962 are in position. A detail of availability of Infrastructure in colleges is given at **Annexure-II**.

(c): Total 6013 Colleges are receiving grants from University Grants Commission under different schemes.

(d): Colleges which are recognized under section **2(f) and 12(B)** and Govt. Aided in nature are provided assistance. Providing of financial assistance under schemes are also subject to fulfilment of conditions laid down in the respective UGC guidelines.

(e): The schemes viz. General Development Assistance to Colleges; Construction of Women's Hostel for Colleges; Autonomous Colleges (Release of Grants only); Minor Research Project for Colleges; Seminar/Symposia/Conference for Colleges; Faculty Development Programme for Colleges; Internal Quality Assurance Cell for Colleges; Development of Sports Infrastructure & Equipments in Colleges; Granting Special Heritage status to Colleges; Visually Challenged Teachers; and Committed Liabilities (old UGC Schemes) are being implemented to promote qualitative education in Government Colleges. Further, the affiliating universities are also mandated to monitor the quality of education in its affiliated colleges including the private colleges under the provisions of [UGC \(Affiliation of Colleges by Universities\) Regulations, 2009](#) as amended from time to time.
