- (a) whether the Archaeological Survey of India has undertaken conservation work at the Patnadevi Temple and Mudhai Devi Temple in Jalgaon, Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the conservation work shall be carried out under a Central scheme and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the budget allocated and expenditure incurred for the conservation of these Temples; and
- (d) whether there is any timeline for the completion of the conservation work and if so, the details thereof?
