1250. SHRI LAVU SRI KRISHNA DEVARAYALU:

- (a) whether the Ministry has decided to grant the title of Institution of National Importance to Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh, along with three other deemed to be Universities;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Cabinet Note has been prepared and sent to the Cabinet for its approval; and
- (d) the time by which the Government would bring Bill to confer the status of an Institution of National Importance to above institution?

(a to d). There is no proposal to convert the three Sanskrit deemed to be Universities including Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidypeetha (RSV), Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh into Institutions of National Importance. However these institutions are proposed to be converted into Central Universities for which a Bill has already been passed in the Lok Sabha.
