- (a) whether the Government is providing funds to Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) for setting up Skill Development Centers for youth in West Bengal;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the funds sanctioned for Non-Governmental Organisations in West Bengal during the current financial year, district-wise;
- (c) the number of youth who got training in the said centers during the last three years along with the names of the trades in which they have been trained and the number of students who got employment; and
- (d) the number of Non-Governmental Organisations selected for funding to open/start Skill Development Centers in West Bengal?

- (c) The number of beneficiaries trained by JSSs of West Bengal during the last three years is given below.

Keeping in view the objective of supplementing the income level of the target group, the JSSs imparts training to the beneficiaries for their livelihood linkages, primarily in the skill-sets required in the informal sector of employment/wage-employment.
