SLOWDOWN IN TAX COLLECTION

Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has experienced a slowdown in tax collection this fiscal year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the plans of the Government for making up for this deficit if such a slowdown is present;
- (d) whether the Government has experienced a shortfall in both direct and indirect tax collection; and
- (e) if so, whether the Government has identified contributing factors for the same and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): The central direct tax and indirect tax collection during the Financial Year 2019-20 (upto December 2019) is as under:
