Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the new guidelines published aligning JSS with National Skills Qualification Framework has been implemented across all JSS;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries who have availed benefits through JSS;
- (d) the variety of jobs, the beneficiaries have secured post vocational training through JSS; and
- (e) whether the Government has put in place a system of incentives to reward better performing JSS and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) There are 248 Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) in the country. State-wise list of JSSs attached at Annexure-A.
- (b) Yes, Sir. JSSs are conducting National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned courses.
- (c) The number of beneficiaries trained by JSSs during 2018-19 & 2019-20 (up-to Jan-2020) is:

2018-19 : 1,67,263
2019-20 : 2,40,315
- (d) Keeping in view the objective of supplementing the income level of the target group, the JSSs imparts training to the beneficiaries for their livelihood linkages, primarily in the skill-sets required in the informal sector of employment/wage-employment viz. cutting & tailoring, beauty culture & health care, electrical technician, plumbing, refrigeration and air conditioning, etc.
- (e) Annual Recurring Grants-in-Aid to JSSs are released after taking into consideration their overall performance. In addition, Government is also actively considering incentivizing good performing JSSs.
