Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the target achieved out of the target set for National Literacy Mission (NLM) in all the States including Maharashtra during the current five years plan;

(b) the State/Union Territory, region-wise and yearwise details of the sanctioned and utilised funds during the last two years and the current year;

(c) the steps taken/proposed to improve the above mission along with the estimated expenditure on the new mission by the Government; and

(d) the number of overall approved projects by the Government under the said mission in the rural areas during the last three years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) Saakshar Bharat Programme, the latest version of National Literacy Mission, was implemented in the rural areas of 410 districts in 26 States and one UT of the country. Under the programme, against the overall target of making 7 crore adult non-literates to be made literates, around 7.64 crore learners successfully passed the biannual Basic Literacy Assessment Tests conducted by National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) between August, 2010 to March, 2018 and were certified as literates. A statement indicating State/UT-wise target of enrolment of learners, learners appeared and declared successful in the biannual Basic Literacy Assessment Tests under programme, including Maharashtra is at **Annexure-I**.

(b) A statement indicating the State/UT-wise central financial assistance provided under the scheme of Saakshar Bharat during the last two years is at **Annexure-II**.

(c) & (d) In order to improve the female literacy rate in the country, the scheme of Saakshar Bharat was implemented in the rural areas of 410 districts in 26 States and one UT, that had adult female literacy rate of 50 per cent and below as per Census 2001, with special focus on women and other disadvantaged groups.
