(a) Data on number of steel plants in the country including West Bengal which are open and temporarily closed for the year 2018-19 are listed in **Annexure-I**.

(b)&(c): Steel is a deregulated sector, and the role of the Government is that of a facilitator. The decision regarding operation/closure of steel plants is taken by individual steel companies from time to time, based on commercial considerations and market dynamics.
