Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of India provides financial assistance to meritorious students of weaker sections to pursue post-graduation courses in B-schools;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the quantum of financial assistance disbursed during the last three years including the current year, in Chennai, Tamil Nadu; and

(c) if not, the reasons thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank')

(a) to (c): Yes. The Department of Higher Education, University Grants Commission, Ministry of Minority Affairs and Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment are providing financial assistance in the form of scholarship /interest subsidy schemes to the meritorious students of weaker sections including the students pursuing post-graduation courses in B-schools. The details of schemes and quantum of financial assistance disbursed during the last three years including the current year in Tamil Nadu is at Annexure-1.
