CRISIS IN AUTOMOBILE INDUSTRIES

- (a) the details and number of auto industries that have declared lay off since April 2018 and the number of permanent, contract and casual workers who have lost their jobs;
- (b) whether these companies obtained permission before lay off, if not, the reasons therefor and the action taken against such companies; and
- (c) whether the companies complied with the law in making payment to the laid off workers and if not, the action taken against such companies?

(a) to (c): Due to cyclical slowdown across various sectors including automobile sector, retrenchment of temporary workers has been reported by the Industry. However, no confirmed data on job loss is available with the Government.
