Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
(a) whether the Government has maintained any updated data on internal migrants in the country and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
(b) whether the data includes other parameters like caste and income data;
(c) the major reasons for internal migration in the country;
(d) whether the Government has considered maintaining more regular data on internal migration given it's prevalence and the increasing pressures to migrate due to climate change and loss of livelihood;
(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
(f) whether the Government proposes to set up a grievance redressal system for the inter-state migrants; and
$(g)$ if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) \& (b): As per last Census conducted in 2011, the State-wise number of all, Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe migrants due to change in place of last residence is given at Annex. Income data is not collected in Census.
(c) to (e): The reasons for migration and number of migrants as per Census 2011 are given below at all India level:
