PROCESSING OF INDIAN GOOSEBERRY

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal to set up a mega Indian Gooseberry (Amla) food processing industry in Pratapgarh or whether any such proposal is pending with or under consideration of the Government in view of large scale farming of Amla in the said Parliamentary Constituency;
