CURBING CHILD LABOUR

1643. DR. VISHNU PRASAD M.K.:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the new initiatives undertaken by the Government have been successful in curbing the Child Labour;
- (b)if so, the comparative data during the last three years and current year; and
- (c)the time by which child labour is likely to be eliminated completely?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): As per 2011 Census, the number of main workers in the age group of 5-14 years in the country is 43.53 lakh which shows a decline from 57.79 lakh as per 2001 Census.

The details of number of children rescued/withdrawn from work, rehabilitated and mainstreamed under National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme during the last three years and current year are as under:

2018-19	50284
2019-20 (till date)	46198

Since child labour is a result of socio-economic conditions, a definite timeline for elimination of child labour cannot be ascertained.
