- (a) the State/UT-wise number of Central and State Universities in the country including West-Bengal;
- (b) the total number of tribal/Scheduled Tribes (ST) women in the Central and State Universities at present in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has implemented any schemes particularly for educated tribal girls; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): The State/UT-wise number of Central and State Universities in the country including West Bengal is given in **Annexure-I**.
- (b): The total State/UT-wise number of Tribal/Scheduled Tribes (ST) women in the 43 Central Universities under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) is at **Annexure-II**. State/UT-wise ST women enrolment in respect of State Universities is not maintained centrally in Ministry of Human Resource Development.
- (c) & (d): The University Grants Commission (UGC) is implementing the following schemes for the benefit of SC/ST Students including women/girls:
  - 1) Residential Coaching Academies of Minorities /SC/ST and Women

- 2) Establishment of Centres in Universities for Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy
- 3) Establishment of Equal Opportunities Cells (EOCs)
- 4) Establishment of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Cells in Universities
- 5) Coaching Schemes for Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ Minorities (i) Remedial Coaching at UG & PG level (ii) Coaching for entry into services (iii) Coaching for NET
- 6) National Fellowship for Higher Education of Scheduled Tribe Students (Formerly Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship for ST Candidates)
