Vocational Training Institutions in Jharkhand

1652. SHRI JAYANT SINHA:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of vocational courses provided as electives to students in Government institutions in Jharkhand;
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to promote vocational education in Jharkhand; and
- (c) the details of year-wise number of students enrolled in vocational courses in Government vocational training institutions in Jharkhand since 2014, district-wise?

(a) to (c): As per the information received from All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), AICTE does not provide any special Vocational Course as elective for the students studying in Government institutions of Jharkhand. However, AICTE in the year 2018, introduced the vocational Degree/ Diploma programmes leading to Degree or Diploma in Vocational Education under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) for AICTE approved institutions. In Jharkhand, 7 institutions were approved to run Vocational Courses in the year 2018-19 in Automotive Manufacturing, Graphics & Media, Software Developer, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Industrial Tools and Electronics Manufactures, the details of which are at **Annexure-I**. In order to create an industry ready workforce and increase employability of students, UGC has facilitated institutions to provide skill based programmes under National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF). UGC has so far implemented three skill based schemes, namely Community Colleges, B.Voc Degree Programme and DDU KAUSHAL Kendra. Currently there are 188 Community Colleges, 289 institutions offering B.Voc Degree Programmes and 68 DDU KAUSHAL Kendras. As on date, 4 institutions from the state of Jharkhand are offering skill based programmes with the approval from UGC, the details of which are at **Annexure –II**. As per the information received from Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, under PradhanMantriKaushalVikasYojna (PMKVY 2016-20), training is being imparted in 371 National Skills Qualification Framework aligned job roles of level 3 and 4 including technical courses across 37 sectors throughout the country. The list of district wise number of candidates trained/oriented under PMKVY (2016-20) in State of Jharkhand is at **annexure-III**.
