**BUILDINGS FOR KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS**

**†1655. DR. DHAL SINGH BISEN:**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that many Kendriya Vidyalayas do not have their own buildings or there is shortage of rooms according to the number of students;
- (b) if so, the State/UT-wise details thereof;
- (c) the names of the Vidyalayas for which funds for the construction of the buildings/rooms has been released along with details thereof;
- (d) the details of the schools of the Madhya Pradesh which do not have sufficient rooms in proportion to the number of the students and also schools without their own buildings; and
- (e) the time by which the said schools are likely to be provided funds?

**ANSWER

(a) & (b) As on date, 283 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are running in the temporary infrastructure provided by various sponsoring authorities. The State / UT-wise details are at Annexure-I.

(c) KV wise details of fund released during the year 2019-20 for the construction of the building/rooms are at Annexure-II

(d) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that there are no such KV in Madhya Pradesh which do not have sufficient rooms in proportion to the number of students. As on date, there are 25 KVs (including 2 KVs in project for which permanent school building is provided by the concerned project authority) namely Chaurai, No.2 Chhindwada, Harda, Malanjkhanda, Pandhurna, Chanderi, GanjBasoda, No. II Neemuch, Dabra, Hattanagar, Lakhnadaun, Umaria, Amba, Jamai, BSF Tekanpur, Multai, CRPF Bangrasia, Kasarwad, Anuppur, Shyamgarh, CRPF Nayagaon, Agar Malwa, Garha, Amarkantak (Project) & Sagar No. 4 (Project) functioning in temporary buildings provided by concerned Sponsoring Authorities in Madhya Pradesh.

(e) Construction of permanent buildings for KVs is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of lease formalities in favour of KVS by the sponsoring authorities, submission of drawings / estimates by construction agency, availability of funds and requisite approvals etc. As such, no definite time frame can be given in this regard.
