Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal for setting up of National Institute of Design (NID) in Telangana;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that the CM of Telangana has submitted a Memorandum to PM in this regard when he met him recently; and
- (c) if so, what action the Government has so far taken on setting up of NID in Telangana?

(a) to (c): As per information received from Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, a proposal has been received for setting up of National Institute of Design (NID) in Telangana and a memorandum was submitted by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Telangana to Hon'ble Prime Minister in this regard.

The National Design Policy 2007, with a view to spreading quality education in design to all the regions of India stated setting up of four NIDs on the lines of NID, Ahmedabad. Accordingly, 4 new NIDs envisaged in the states of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Madhya Pradesh and Haryana, located in Amravati, Jorhat, Bhopal and Kurukshetra respectively, were approved in the meeting of the cabinet held on 25.02.2014. All the 4 new NIDs have commenced academic activities and their campuses are under construction. As all four NIDs envisaged under the National Design Policy 2007 have been set up, there is currently, no plan to establish any new NID.
