SKILL DEVELOPMENT TO UNEMPLOYED TRIBAL YOUTH

175. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to provide adequate training for the educated unemployed tribal youths as the skill development;
- (b) if so, the number of such training centres proposed to be set up in the Scheduled districts of Odisha and other States; and
- (c) if steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI R. K. SINGH)

(a) to (c) Under Skill India Mission, the Government of India is implementing various schemes for imparting employable skills to the youths including Scheduled Tribes (ST)candidates through short term and long term programs. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) under its flagship program, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 2016-20 (PMKVY 2016-20) provides short term training to the youths including tribal youths through affiliated training partners/training centres. As on 17.01.2020, 13209 Training Centres including 350 Training centres (TCs) in Odisha and 723 Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKKs) including 28 PMKKs in Odisha have been empanelled for imparting training. Further, in Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) under MSDE there is a provision for reservation of seats for training of Scheduled Tribes candidates.
