**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has any programme for assuring jobs to the skilled workers being trained by the skill council and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the target for skilling youth in 2019 could not be achieved;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether the skill training programme keep to adapting labour market changes in the country and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) Under Skill India Mission, there are more than 20 central Ministries/Departments which are implementing schemes for imparting employable skills to the youth through short term and long term training.. Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has been implementing "Pradhan Mantri Kaushal VikasYojana (PMKVY 2.0)" 2016-20 on pan-India basis with a target to provide skilling to one crore people under which 23,85,108 persons have been enrolled against a target of 25,00,000 so far. It is expected this target would be achieved by the end of the year.

To adapt to the labour market ,the PMKVY actively seek input from industry through SSCs to keep abreast with changes and requirement of employer industry and incorporate in the course curriculum. Skill Courses have been designed leveraging new age technology to meet the Industry 4.0 requirement and new trades on Internet of Things (IoT), Smart Agriculture, Geo informatics assistant, Aeronautical Structure & Equipment Fitter, Drone, Solar Technician, Technician Mechatronics etc under Craftsmen Training Scheme have been introduced .

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
