Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has achieved the desired results of developing the IT applications to improve efficiency, transparency and accountability in Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Schemes in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, scheme-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries of the said schemes, as on date, State/UT-wise and scheme-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has received complaints in implementation of the said schemes since inception;
- (e) if so, the details thereof, scheme-wise and the reasons therefor along with the present status of such complaints; and
- (f) the other steps taken by the Government for effective implementation and to increase coverage of the said schemes in the country?
