SWACCH BHARAT MISSION IN RAJASTHAN

1925. SHRIMATI RANJEETA KOLI:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the works carried out in the districts of Rajasthan under Swachh Bharat Mission and the amount of funds allocated/released/utilized under the Mission during the last three years; and
- (b) the estimated number of people benefited from Swachh Bharat Mission in Rajasthan?

(a): As per information received from the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Ministry of Jal Shakti, under Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) [SBM (G)], 83,52,303 individual household latrines (IHHLs) and 3286 community sanitary complexes (CSCs) have been constructed in Rajasthan and all the 42,860 villages have declared themselves Open Defecation Free (ODF).

Since SBM(G) is a demand driven scheme, no fixed allocation is made to the States under the programme. However, Central share released to Rajasthan under SBM (G) and fund utilized by the State during the last three years are as under:

Year	Funds released (Rs. In crore)	Funds utilized (Rs. In crore)
2016-17	777.30	1065.63
2017-18	981.51	848.21
2018-19	865.88	350.19

(b): About 4.17 crore people (@ 5 people/household) are estimated to have benefited from SBM (G) in Rajasthan.
