BENEFICIARIES UNDER PMAY-G

1936. SHRI ARUN SAO:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT**be pleased to state:

- a) the number of beneficiaries for whom houses have been constructed in rural areas including in Chhattisgarh under Pradhan Mantri AwasYojana-Gramin(PMAY-G) during the last three years and the funds sanctioned by the Union Government for this purpose, State-wise;
- (b) the number of complaints regarding irregularities in the construction of houses received during the last one year and the action taken against the responsible officers; and
- (c) the total number of houses yet to be constructed in rural areas of Bilaspur and Mungeli districts of Chhattisgarh?

ANSWER MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a): To achieve the objective of Housing for All by year 2022, the erstwhile rural housing scheme, Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) has been completely restructured into Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) w.e.f. 1st April, 2016.

State/UT-wise number of houses constructed under PMAY-G for last 3 years is given in Annexure I. State/UT-wise Central Releases under PMAY-G during last 3 years are given in Annexure II.

(b): As per Framework for Implementation (FFI) of PMAY-G, a grievance redressal mechanism has been set up at different levels of administration viz., Gram Panchayat, Block, District and the State level. An official of the State Government is to be designated at each level to ensure disposal of grievances to the satisfaction of the complainant. The official who is designated at each level is responsible for disposing off the grievance / complaint within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the grievance / complaint. The detail of the designated grievance redressal official (including name, telephone number and address) at each level for addressing the grievance and the procedure to file the grievance is to be prominently displayed in each Panchayat. There is also a procedure of lodging of complaints on the Centralized Public Grievance Redress And Monitoring System (CPGRAMS) portal (pgportal.gov.in).

During the year 2018-19, 252 complaints relating to irregularities in implementation of PMAY-G, including irregularities in allotment of houses (i.e. allotment of house to ineligible persons, non-allotment of house to eligible persons, etc.) were received in Ministry of Rural Development. These complaints have been forwarded to the concerned States /UTs for taking necessary action as per the provisions of the guidelines of the PMAY-G.

(c): Number of eligible beneficiaries in the Permanent Wait List (PWL), Target Allocated, Houses Sanctioned, Houses Completed and Balance in PWL in Bilaspur and Mungeli Districts of Chhattisgarh, as on 29.02.2020, are as under:
