STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2172 BY DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 04.03.2020 REGARDING SURVEY OF RAILWAY PROJECTS IN MAHARASHTRA

(a) and (b): Railway projects are not surveyed State-wise. Surveys are undertaken based on various considerations such as demands raised by State Governments, Central Ministries, Members of Parliament, other public representatives, Railway's own operational requirement, last mile connectivity etc. However, 21 surveys of new lines/gauge conversion falling fully/partly in the State of Maharashtra have been completed in last three years and current year (2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20). 11 projects of new lines/gauge conversion falling fully/partly in the State of Maharashtra have been included in Budget subject to requisite Government approvals during the last three years and current year (2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20). Details are as under:

Railway Electrification: Ministry of Railways has planned to electrify balance Broad Gauge (BG) routes of Indian Railways by December, 2023 including the State of Maharashtra.

Presently, under Plan Head "Railway Electrification", 12 electrification projects of 2,691 km length with costing of ₹3,122 crore falling fully/partly in the State of Maharashtra are in progress. Out of which, commissioning of 144 km has been achieved.

Electrification of Rail routes will reduce Nation's dependence on imported fossil based fuels i.e. diesel oil.
