Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has assessed the reported decline in the annual income earned from the post offices in the country;

(b) if so, the details and the outcome thereof along with the reasons therefor;

(c) whether the Government propose to open more post offices in the Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh and if so, the details thereof;

(d) the time by which the said post offices are likely to be opened; and

(e) whether all the facilities are being provided to customers in the post offices of the said district and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) Since there is no decline in the annual income earned from the post offices in the country in the last 3 financial years as per details given below, no such assessment was required. However, scheme and product-wise assessment & its performances are regularly assessed by the concerned operating divisions for implementing and changes as required.

(b) No such assessment was required for overall decline, some traditional schemes like Flat-Rate Parcel, Express Parcel gradually closed. Department of Posts periodically reviews its services and products keeping in view the changing market scenario, customer needs, industry benchmarks etc and takes steps/action to modify service features to improve the postal services and boost the revenue growth of the Department. Technology integration and infrastructure upgradation is also being done in a systematic manner to increase the efficiency.
