VACANCIES IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN TELANGANA

229. SHRI MANNE SRINIVAS REDDY:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in Telangana, district-wise;
- (b) whether it is true that there are a large number of vacancies of teachers in KVs;
- (c) if so, the details of vacancies, KV-wise including posts of Principals and Vice-Principals; and
- (d) the steps taken to fill in the posts and by when all the vacancies are going to be filled?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')**

(a) As on date, 35 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are functioning in the State of Telangana. District-wise details are at Annexure-I.

(b)& (c) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has informed that as on 15.11.2019, there are 178 teaching posts lying vacant against 1293 sanctioned posts in different KVs located in the State of Telangana. The KVs wise details of vacancies of teachers (including Principals & Vice-principal) are at Annexure-II.

(d) During the year 2019-20 (upto January, 2020) 366 teachers including PGTs/TGTs and PRTs were appointed in the KVs in Telangana. Teachers are also engaged on contractual basis for temporary duration by KVS to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered. Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and action is taken from time to time as per the provisions of the relevant recruitment rules. As the process of filling up of vacancies involves various methods of recruitment such as promotion, Limited Departmental Examination, Direct Recruitment etc. and takes time, no specific time frame for filling up of vacant posts can be given at this stage.

Directions have also been issued to autonomous organizations including KVS from time to time, for reviewing their vacancies and for taking prompt action for filling up of vacant posts in the Vidyalayas.
