- (a) the percentage of representation of Scheduled Castes/Schedule Tribes officials working on the posts of Secretary, Joint Secretary, Additional Secretary and Deputy Secretary in the Government services along with their total number till date; and
- (b) the number of persons belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes categories who have been promoted to the higher posts in the Government services during the last three years and the details thereof, State/ UT-wise?

- (a): The representation based data is collected only at the time of initial recruitment. Appointment/promotion to senior positions is not on representation basis and such data is accordingly not maintained.
- (b): The number of appointments made through promotion in respect of SCs and STs in Group A posts, as per information received from various Ministries/ Departments, as on 1.1.2016, 1.1.2017 and 1.1.2018, is as follows:-
