- (a) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) [SBM(G)], 66.15 lakh individual household latrines (IHHLs) have been constructed in Madhya Pradesh and all the 50,228 villages of Madhya Pradesh have declared themselves Open Defecation Free (ODF) as on 2.10.2019. The Government has further advised all the States including Madhya Pradesh to ensure that no one is left behind under SBM(G) and to identify the missed out rural households, if any, and support them to construct toilets under the programme.
