FUNCTIONING OF FASTAG SYSTEM

2405. SHRI DEVJI M. PATEL: MS. PRATIMA BHOUMIK:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सडक परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any data with regard to the number of FASTag issued in the last one year and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has received complaints against the toll operators due to non-working of FASTag scanner/system and if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government is aware of an increase in the number of complaints against the toll operators' behaviour with the passengers; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government against the toll operators?

ANSWER

- (a) The State/UT-wise details of the FASTag issued on the basis of Vehicle registration number for the period of 1st March 2019 to 27th Feb 2020 are at **Annexure**.
- (b) to (d) FASTag related issues and complaints at fee plazas of National Highways (NH) are addressed through a central NH Helpline Number 1033. Most of the complaints are resolved instantly by the customer executive. Other complaints are forwarded to concerned regional office of National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) and banks for necessary resolution. Apart from 1033, 24 participating banks of FASTag programme also have their own dedicated customer care helpline to cater to complaints of respective customer base. Complaints against toll operators have been received in some of the fee plazas. The issues are forwarded to concerned Project Implementation Unit (PIU) for proper investigation and necessary action. In case, there is any fault on part of toll operating agencies, action is taken as per the provisions of Contract Agreement.
