Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:-

(a) whether due to the lack of awareness, the benefits of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) schemes are not reaching common people as a result of which the funds allocated in the budget are not being utilized properly;

(b) if so, whether the Government proposes to spread awareness about its schemes to boost the business of small entrepreneurs;

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the funds spent out of the funds allocated in the budget during the last five years and the current year?

(a) to (d): Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) implements various schemes for organising Industrial Motivation Campaigns, Vendor Development Programmes, Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programmes.
