- (a) the funds released by the Government to the States especially for poverty alleviation of backward and poor people during each of the last two years till date under the Integrated Urban Poverty Alleviation Programme, State and year-wise; and**
- (b) the details of the achievements of the States especially in backward areas during the said period, year-wise and State-wise?**

- (a) With the aim to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme viz “Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM)” since 2014 in the statutory towns in the country, to be decided by States/UTs based on their requirement and local capacity. During 2018-19 to 2019-20, funds amounting to Rs 1087.62 crores have been released to States/UTs towards implementation of Mission. A statement showing state-wise details of funds released to States/UTs during this period under the Mission, year-wise, is at Annexure-I.**
- (b) A statement showing details of physical progress of States/UTs under DAY-NULM during the period 2016-17 to 2017-18, are at Annexure-II.**
