### **DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL WATERWAYS**

#### 2517. SHRI RAMESH CHANDRA MAJHI:

Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any step on priority basis to implement the development process for first two phases of National Waterway (NW) No. 5 *i.e.* Talcher Industrial area with Dhamara and Paradip Port, which will connect industrial as well as coal mining area to the port; and
- (b) whether steps are being taken by the Government to develop NW-14, NW-22, NW-23, NW-64 and NW-96 and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR SHIPPING (SHRI MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

- (a) The Following development activities related to shipping and navigation have been taken up by the Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) on the stretch of National Waterway (NW-5) form Talcher to Dhamra/Paradip, Pankapal and Mangalgadi.
  - (i) Monthly longitudinal Bathymatric survey (Thalweg Survey in Phase-I).
  - (ii) Consultancy work for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) including Front End Engineering Design (FEED) for construction of 4 weirs cum barrages with 3 navigational locks, 2 check dams & 1 rubber dam with navigational lock.
  - (iii) Consultancy work for preparation of Detailed Engineering Report (DER) including FEED for Modification/ Reconstruction of existing 09 Bridges on NW-5.
  - (iv) Detailed hydrographic survey between Talcher and Pankapal for model study.
- (b) As per Feasibility Report (FR)/ Detailed Project Report (DPR), development of shipping and navigation for the purpose of commercial cargo transportation on NW-14 (Baitarani River), NW-64 (Mahanadi river), NW-22 (Birupara-Badi Genguti-Brahmani river system), NW-23 (Budha-Balanga river) and NW-96 (Subarnrekha River) have not been found feasible by the IWAI. The FR/ DPRs of the aforementioned NWs have been shared by the IWAI with the State Governments for development of ferry/ cruise services etc., in these NWs as per their requirements.
