CORONAVIRUS MEDICINE

2640. SHRI ANTO ANTONY:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to provide medical or any other assistance to China, which is very badly affected due to coronavirus, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has identified any suitable medicine to prevent coronavirus;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government has issued any guidelines/notification/ban on import from Coronavirus affected countries; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. HARSH VARDHAN)

- (a): Government of India mounted a relief assistance flight to Wuhan, China on 26.02.2020 which brought over 15 tons of medical assistance comprising masks, gloves and other emergency medical equipment for Chinese healthcare professionals.
- (b) & (c): There is no specific treatment or vaccine for Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Treatment is supportive. Guidelines on Clinical Management of severe respiratory illness (SARI) in suspect / confirmed COVID-19 cases, Surveillance for human infection with COVID-19, Infection Prevention and Control in healthcare facilities, etc. have been placed in public domain on the website of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare at weblink https://mohfw.gov.in/node/4904.
- (d) & (e): No such proposal is under consideration in the Ministry.
