- (a) whether the Government has approved the setting up of a 50-bedded integrated AYUSH hospital in Anantgiri, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District of Telangana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether DPR has been prepared for the said project; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, the funds allocated for the same and the time by which this hospital is likely to become operational?

(a) to (d): Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), Government of India has approved setting up of upto 50-bedded integrated AYUSH hospital in Anantgiri, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District of Telangana during 2016-17.

State Government has prepared the DPR for Rs. 600.00 lakhs and submitted to Government of India. Accordingly, proposal of 50-bedded integrated AYUSH hospital in Anantgiri, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District of Telangana has been approved and grant-in-aid of Rs 360.00 lakhs has been released as central share during the year 2016-17. Further, as per information received from State Government of Telangana, this hospital is to be made functional after recruitment of manpower.
