- (a) whether there is any provision to take permission from his Ministry for news web portal prevalent on social media and youtube;
- (b) if not, whether the Government is considering for mandatory registration of such portals on the lines of RNI to put a control over them; and
- (c) if so, the time by which such a decision is likely to be implemented?

The draft Bill has been placed on the website of the Ministry for seeking comments of the stakeholders and general public.
