Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Anganwadi Centres constructed across the country during the last three years;
- (b) whether the Government has proposed to construct more Anganwadi Centres across the country and if so, the details of such proposals and sites of construction, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the time by which these centres are likely to be constructed?

- (a) The number of Anganwadi Centres constructed in the country under Anganwadi Services in convergence with Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last three years are as under :

- (b) Under the revised scope of Anganwadi Services implemented from 01.12.2017, the Central assistance for construction of new Anganwadi Centre building is available in rural areas in convergence with MGNREGS on reimbursement basis. Under the said scope, State Government of Andhra Pradesh have constructed 3960 AWCs during 2018-19.

In the current financial year, Government has proposed 58670 number of more Anganwadi Centres across the country. State/UT-wise details are at Annexure.

- (c) The Anganwadi Services Scheme is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, wherein the Central Government in the Ministry of Women and Child Development is responsible for program planning while the responsibility of implementation of the scheme including construction of AWCs rests with States / UTs.
