- (a) the details of institutional deliveries that took place in the country during each of the last three years and the number of women who got financial assistance;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated and utilised for the promotion of institutional deliveries, State-wise during the last three years;
- (c) whether there has been a decline or increase in the rate of institutional deliveries in the country during the last three years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?
