### CRITERIA FOR SETTING UP OF CGHS WELLNESS CENTRES

# 2731. SHRI BHAGIRATH CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the details of criteria fixed for setting up of dispensaries/hospitals under the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) in the country;

(b) the dispensaries/hospitals functioning under the CGHS in the country at present, State/UT-wise;

(c) the number of beneficiaries who had got treatment in Rajasthan under the CGHS during the last five years, district-wise;

(d) whether the Government proposes to set up new dispensaries/hospitals in the districts having more than 1000 beneficiaries under the CGHS; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be done?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. HARSH VARDHAN)

(a): The criteria fixed for setting up a Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Wellness Centre in a particular area are as under:-

- I. In an existing CGHS City:- For opening of a new Allopathic CGHS Wellness Centre in an existing CGHS city, there has to be a minimum of 2000 Card holders (serving employees of Central Government and Central Civil pensioners).
- II. **Extension of CGHS to a new City:-** For extension of CGHS to a new city, there has to be a minimum of 6,000 Card holders.

Proposals for setting up of new Wellness Centres are considered as per extant norms and subject to availability of resources.

(b): A statement showing number of CGHS Allopathic Dispensaries/Wellness Centres functioning in the country, state-wise is at **Annexure**.

(c): CGHS is in operation in Jaipur. Apart from this, the scheme is also operational in Ajmer, Jodhpur and Kota since 01.04.2019 after takeover of Postal dispensaries in these cities/districts.
