**(a) and (b): Station redevelopment is planned by leveraging real estate potential of sparable land and air space in and around the stations. It is Railway's endeavour to generally develop stations at no cost to Railways on PPP mode. For this, Railway conducts techno-economic feasibility studies of stations across the country. Based on the outcome of these feasibility studies, stations are taken up for redevelopment in phases.**

**(c) and (d): At present the works of station redevelopment have been taken up at Habibganj (Madhya Pradesh) on PPP mode.**
