(a) to (c): Bharatpur railway station was declared as Model station in the year 2006. The station has already been developed under the Model railway station scheme and several works like retiring rooms, common waiting rooms with bathing facilities, separate waiting rooms for ladies and gents, separate waiting rooms for upper and second class, circulating area with parking facility, train indicator board, water coolers, signages, cloak room, enquiry & computer based announcement, public address system, refreshment rooms, booksalls and other stalls for essential goods have been completed under this scheme.
