Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of single sub-post offices currently operational in the State of Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (b) whether the Government intends to convert/ demolish all the single sub-post offices working in the Ajmer Lok Sabha constituency into binary post offices;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which it is likely to be done;
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the existing vacancy for the post of Multi Tasking Staff, Postmen, Postal Assistant, Higher Selection Grade (HSG)-I and HSG-II in the Ajmer along with the sanctioned strength for the aforesaid posts in the said division and the time since when these posts are lying vacant?

ANSWER

- (a) Sir, a total of 728 Single handed Sub Post Offices are currently operational in the State of Rajasthan. The district -wise details are at **Annexure-A**
- (b) to (d) No, Sir. No proposal to convert/ demolish all the single handed sub- post offices working in the Ajmer Lok Sabha constituency into binary post offices is under consideration, since these Single handed Post Offices provides for easy access to public of all their post office requirements.
- (e) A total 138 posts comprising of Multi-Tasking Staff, Postmen, Postal Assistant, Higher Selection Grade(HSG-I)and HSG-II are lying vacant in Ajmer Division from the date of retirement/promotion/transfer/death/resignation of last incumbent. The details of category wise existing vacancy are as under: -
