- (a) the salient features of Government Land Information System (GLIS);
- (b) whether the lands of sick Central Public Sector units will be available for affordable housing projects in cities: and
- (c) if so the details thereof, including the details of locations where land has been given for affordable housing?

ANSWER

- (a) The Government Land Information System (GLIS) is an institutional framework for a centralized and transparent data bank of land belonging to Government of India, Government controlled Statutory Authorities, and Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs).
- (b) As per Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) guidelines issued on 14.06.2018, the disposal of land of sick Central Public Sector Units (CPSEs) will be under the control of administrative Ministry/Department with a priority being given to set up affordable housing projects across the country as per guidelines of Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs.
- (c) At present, no location has been identified where the land of sick CPSE can be utilized to set up of affordable housing project.
