- (a) Yes Sir. The Government has recently conferred the National Highways Excellence Awards, 2019.
- (b) National Highways Excellence Awards has been instituted in 2018 with the objective of incentivising exemplary work and encouraging best industry practices in the Highway development sector.

Estimated expenditure on the National Highways Excellence Awards, 2019 is about Rs1.58 Crores.

- (c) National Highways Excellence Awards, 2019 had following 7 award categories:
  - i. Project Management (PPP & EPC)
  - ii. Operation & Maintenance
  - iii. Toll Management
  - iv. Highway Safety(Plain Terrain, Hilly Terrain)
  - v. Green Highway
  - vi. Innovation
  - vii. Outstanding Work in Challenging Conditions

The best performers were selected based on multiple rounds of rigorous assessment including field assessment of their project profiles by independent agency & jury.

- (d) Out of total 104 nominations received, 12 were conferred awards.
- (e) & (f) The Government is constantly committed towards the larger objective of strengthening and augmenting the road infrastructure in the country. Acknowledging companies who are performing exceptionally well and delivering finest quality services during construction, operation, tolling and maintenance stages of the highway project would encourage all companies in the sector to improve the quality of service.
