- (a) the details of roads being constructed in the State of Jharkhand under the Bharatmala Pariyojana;
- (b) the time-frame set to complete these projects;
- (c) whether there has been delay in construction of these roads and if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to complete these projects within the stipulated time frame?

- (a) & (b) Total four National Highway corridors with an aggregate length of about 784 km. had been identified for development under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the State of Jharkhand. The entire Bharatmala Pariyojana is targeted for completion in a span of five year.
- (c) & (d) No Sir, However, major impediments in the way of progress of National Highway Projects is delay in land acquisition, forest clearances, wild life clearances and utility shifting. These clearances are concerned with the State Government and are being pursued regularly at different level in order to expedite completion of the project.
