- (i) Eviction procedure under Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act, 1971.
- (ii) Allotment of land for construction of permanent houses to the slums dwellers under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Scheme in consultation State Government.
- (iii) Construction of compound wall to protect the port land.
- (iv) Regular Inspection of Port land and deployment of security guard.
- (v) Period encroachment removal drives.
