- (a) to (b) The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the Theni ó Munnar ó Kochi stretch of NH ó 85 including Muvattupuzha to Kothamangalam has been initiated.
- (c) to (d) Some 4/6-lane projects executed through National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) have been delayed due to various reasons such as Public protest, delay in land acquisition, non-availability of burrow earth & aggregates and delay in Forest clearance etc. The details of such major projects along with the expenditure incurred during the years 2018-19 and 2019-20 are as below:
