NEW CAPITALS FOR ANDHRA PRADESH

318. SHRI JAYADEV GALLA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note of the recent decision taken by the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh to set up three capitals for the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) the manner in which the said move is likely to help the State and the people;
- (d) whether the Government would advice the State Government not to resort to such decisions which not only vitiate the investment climate but will also be a great loss to thousands of farmers who have given their land for construction of new capital Amaravati; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): Government of Andhra Pradesh had notified Amaravati as the Capital City, vide its G.O. dated 23.04.2015.
