(a) & (b) During the last three years, four new Greenfield Airports have been constructed and operationalized across the country. These airports are (i) Shirdi Airport in Maharashtra, (ii) Pakyong Airport in Sikkim, (iii) Kannur Airport in Kerala and (iv) Kalaburagi (Gulbarga) Airport in Karnataka. The international flights have started from Kannur Airport. During the Winter Schedule 2019, international flights have operated from Kannur Airport to Abu Dhabi, Muscat, Bahrain, Kuwait, Dammam and Kingkhalid (Saudi Arabia), Doha, Sharjah and Dubai.
