Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note that many Anganwadi Kendras across the country lack basic facilities such as toilets, power and drinking water and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has proposed to develop Adarsh Anganwadi Kendra/modern Anganwadis across the country, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Jalore Sirohi constituency;
- (c) whether the Government has proposed to equip all Anganwadi Centres with solar panels across the country to provide 24x7 power supply and if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (d) whether the Government has taken note of Anganwadi food scams and if so, the details thereof along with the action taken in this regard, State/UT-wise including Haryana?

ANSWER

- (a) State/UT-wise details of number of Anganwadi Centres with drinking water and toilet facilities is Annexed.
- (b) & (c) The scheme provides for up-gradation and improvement of infrastructural facilities in AWC buildings @ Rs. 2.00 lakh per AWC building, maintenance @ Rs.3,000/- per AWC and furniture & equipment @ Rs.10,000/- per AWC and @ Rs.7,000/- per Mini-AWC once in 5 years. Apart from this, funds for construction of Toilets and for providing drinking water facilities in AWCs are also provided to States/UTs. In addition, funds @ Rs. 5,000/- per AWC per annum is provided to States/UTs for imparting non-formal pre-school education to the children in all AWCs.
- (d) No instance of food scam has come to the notice of the Ministry. However, this Ministry has received 39 complaints during last five years regarding services at Anganwadi Centres in the country which have been transferred to concerned State Government for taking necessary action.
