3321. SHRI ANTO ANTONY:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish Model Rural Health Research Units in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the number of such units established in the country, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) the salient features of such research units;
- (d) whether the Government has any plan to set up more units in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

- (a): The Government has been implementing a Central Sector Scheme for Establishment of Model Rural Health Research Units (MRHRU) since 2013-14.
- (b): Details are annexed as Annexure.
- (c): The salient features of such research units are :-
 - I. To develop state/area specific models depending upon the disease profile, morbidity patterns and local conditions, for transfer of technology for providing better health care services to the rural masses.
 - II. To train the health professionals under State Health Systems for use of modern field adaptable methods and develop models for translational purposes to improve health status of rural masses.
 - III. To undertake various research projects in close coordination with the State Government institutions and others that are relevant and beneficial to the rural population.

(d) & (e): These units are set-up as per proposals received from the State Governments in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme and this is a continuing process.
