(a) to (d): According to 4th All India Handloom Census there are 35,22,512 handloom workers in all over India including Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh State. Detail of State-wise no. of handloom workers is enclosed in Annexure- "A".

Budgetary allocation of funds is not made State-wise. The funds are released to eligible agencies based on the viable proposals received and utilization of previous release funds. The Office of the Development Commissioner for Handlooms sanctions and releases funds to the eligible handloom agencies for implementation of various schemes. Details of funds released in the last three years and the current year for various schemes are as under: -
